

## Fairthorne Manor Kit List

*“There’s no such thing as bad weather, just bad clothing”.* We’ve heard this comment for years, but it’s certainly true and some preparation will make your child’s stay much more comfortable. Below is a suggested list of clothing and other items that your child will find useful during their visit.

- Sunhat
- Sun cream
- Waterproof coat and trousers
- Towel and wash kit (bring 2 towels if staying residentially)
- Medication
- Refillable water bottle
- Bin bag for wet or dirty clothes
- 1 pair of trainers
- 1 pair of wellies or walking boots
- 1 pair of water shoes (spare pair of trainers or wetsuit shoes - crocs, flipflops or wellington boots are not appropriate for water activities, footwear must be attached to feet)
  
- Sleeping bag, pillow and pillow case, a fitted sheet for the bed is also recommended
- Plenty of comfortable clothing that can get dirty
- T-shirts
- Several sweatshirts / pullovers (lots of thin layers)
- Light-weight trousers or tracksuit bottoms
- Spare underclothes and extra socks
- Disco outfit
- Slippers
- Torch
- Pyjamas
- Non-breakable camping mug for a hot drink in the evenings
