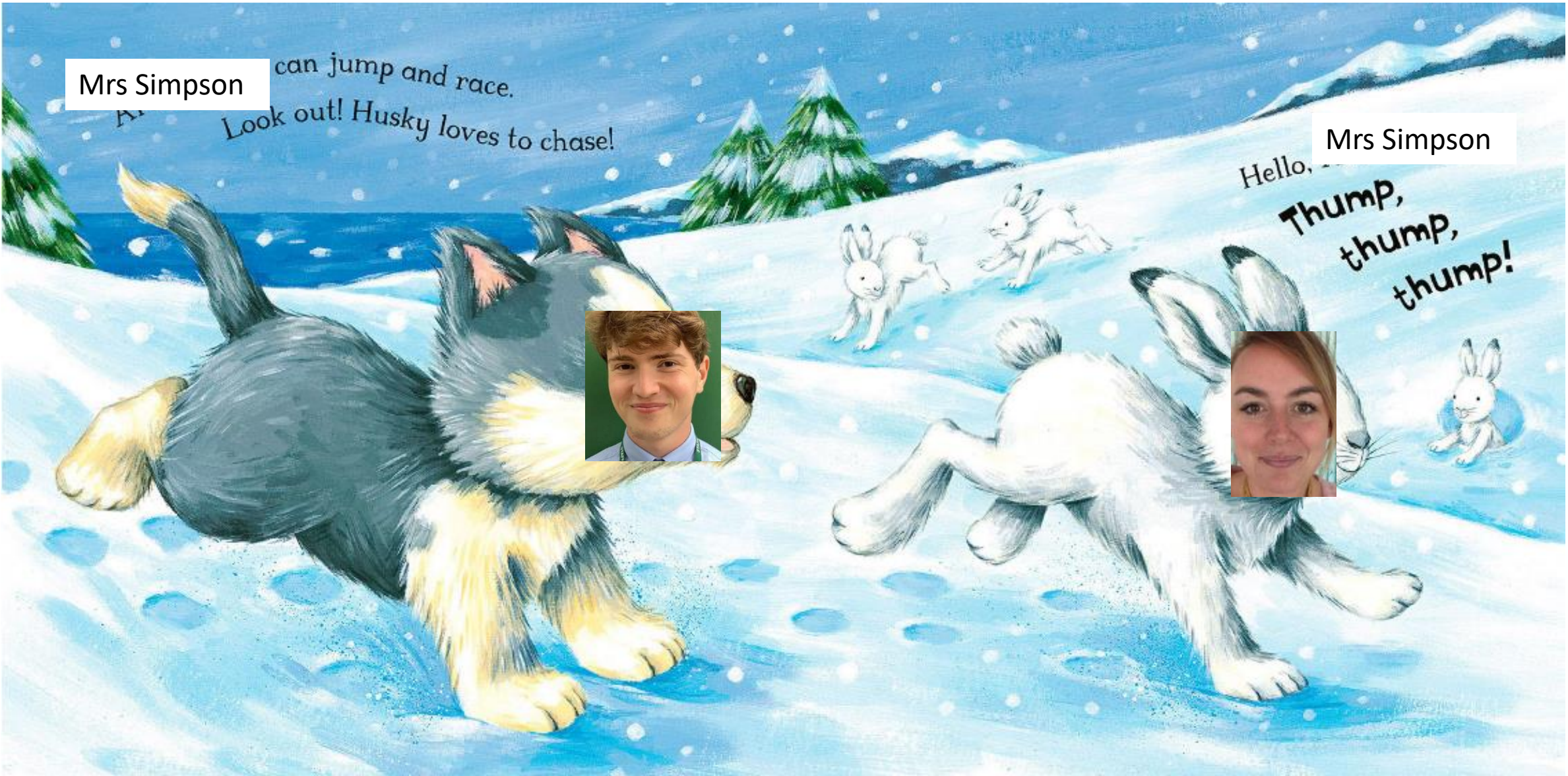


Mrs Simpson
