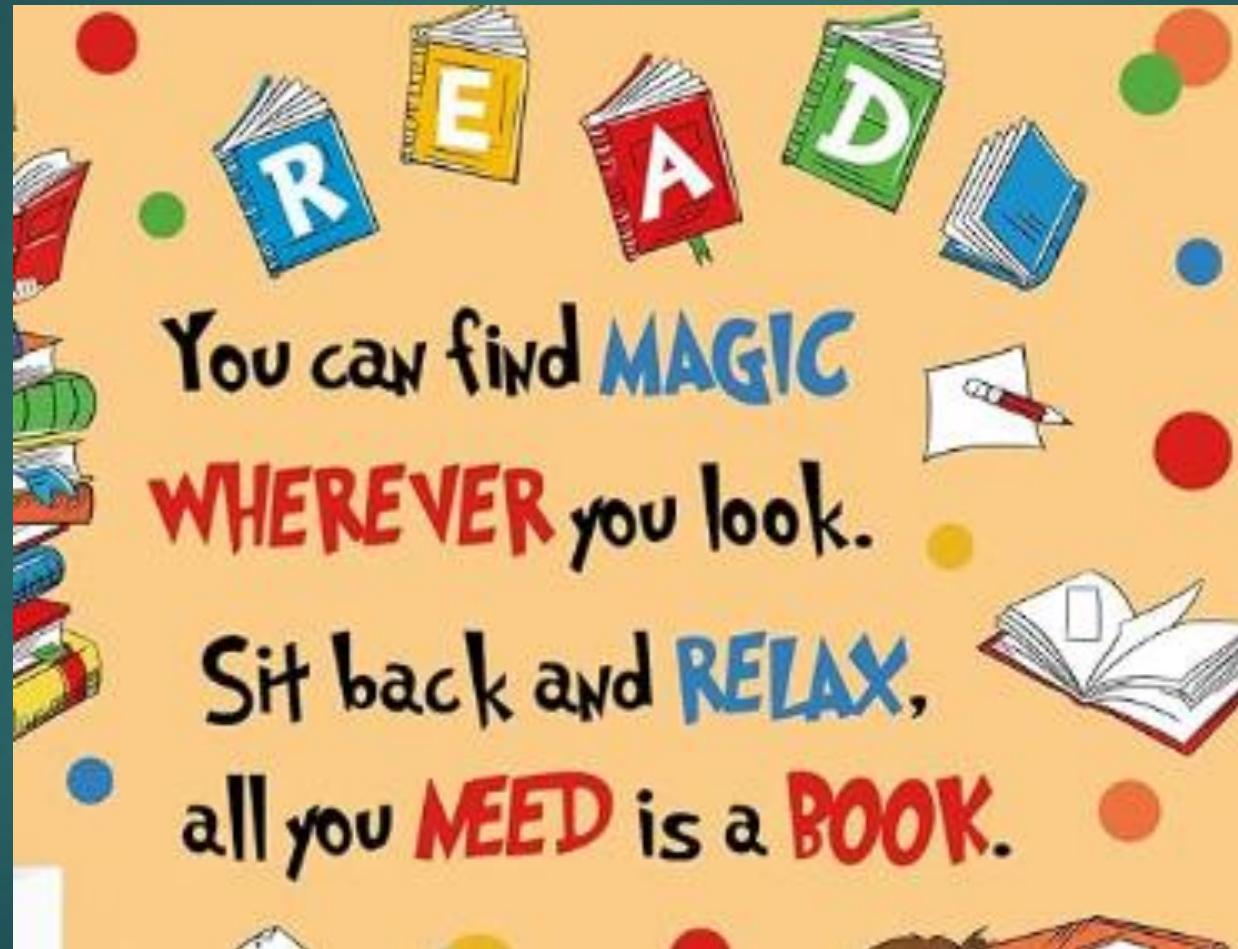

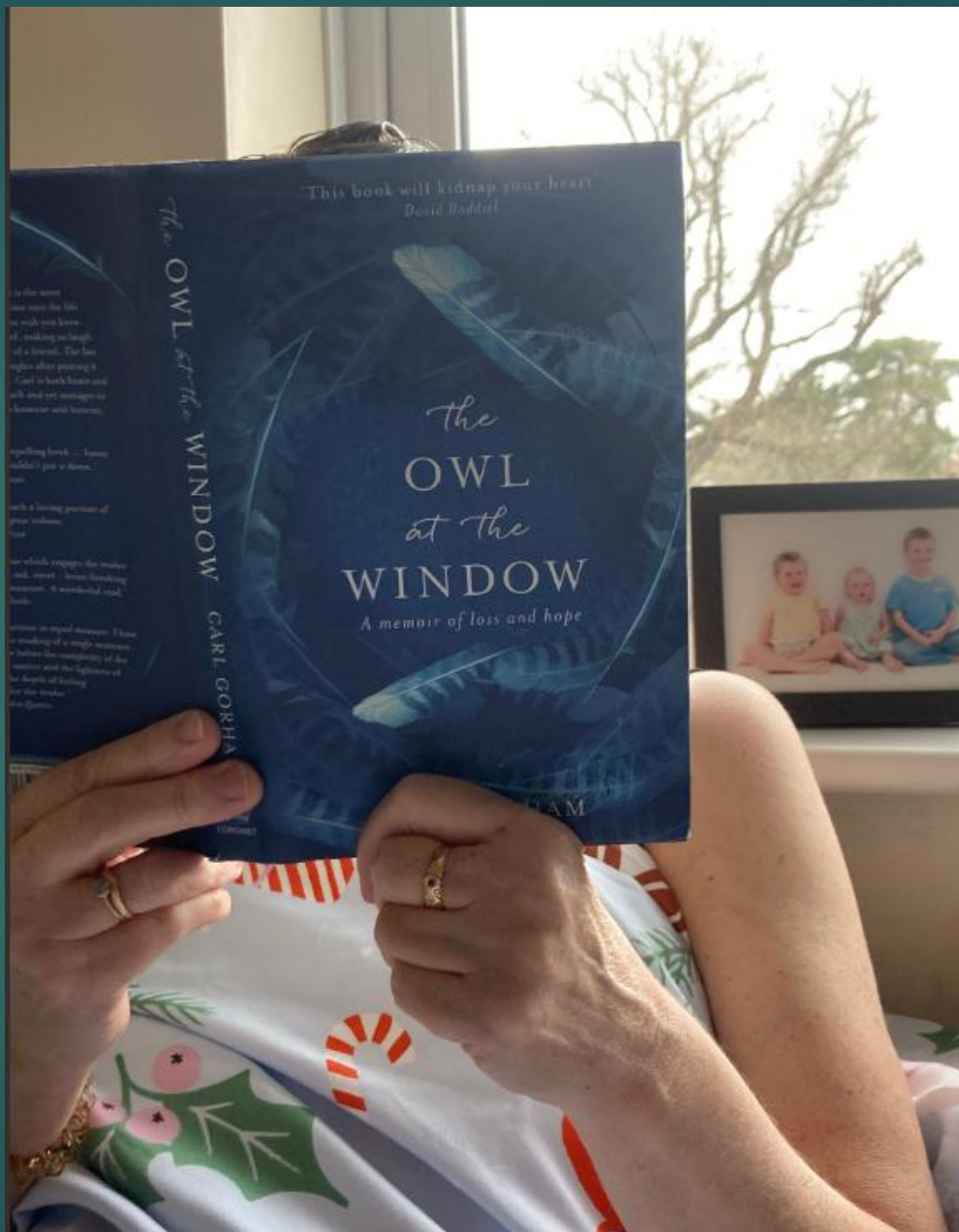
Aspiration and Well-Being

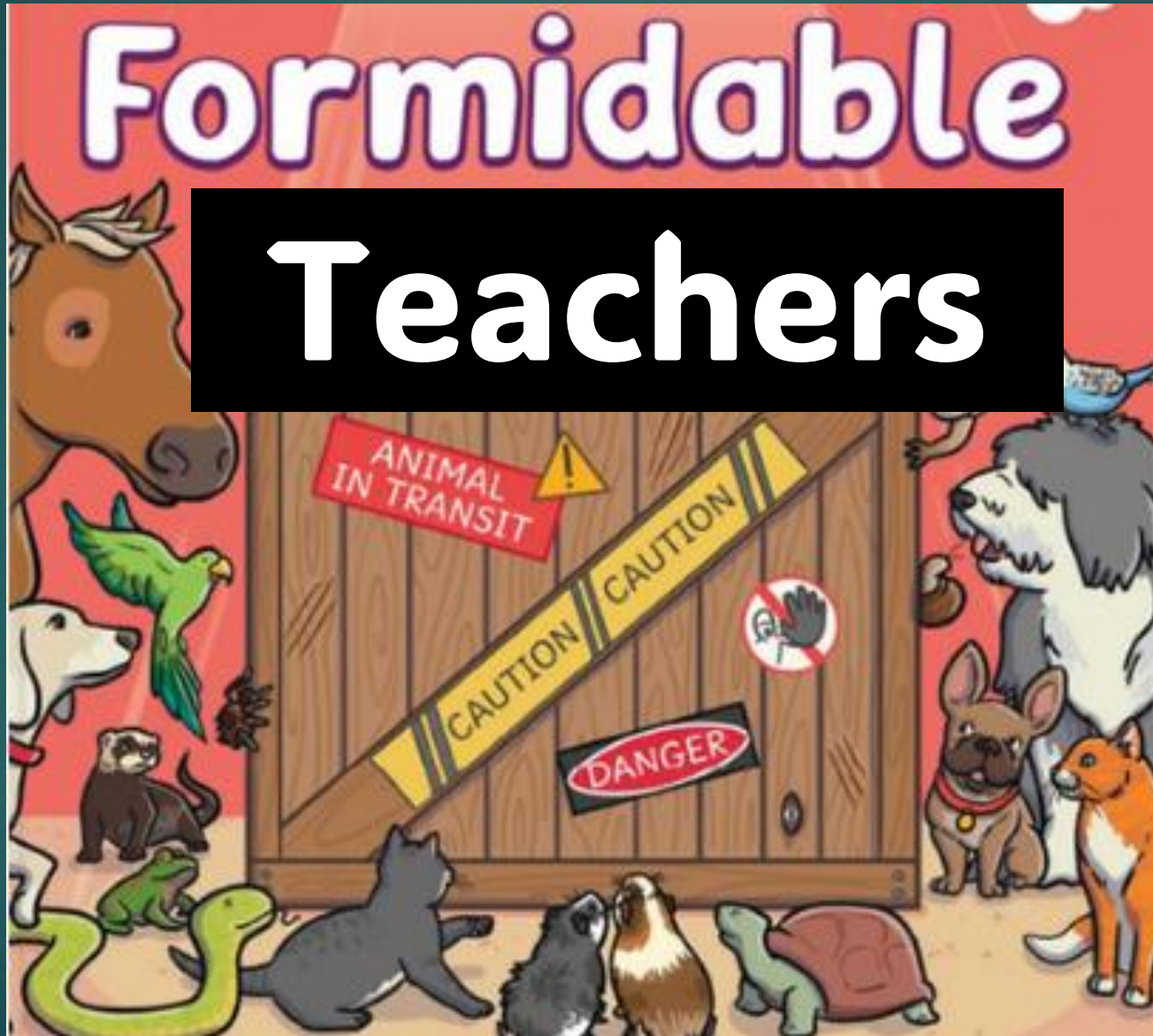

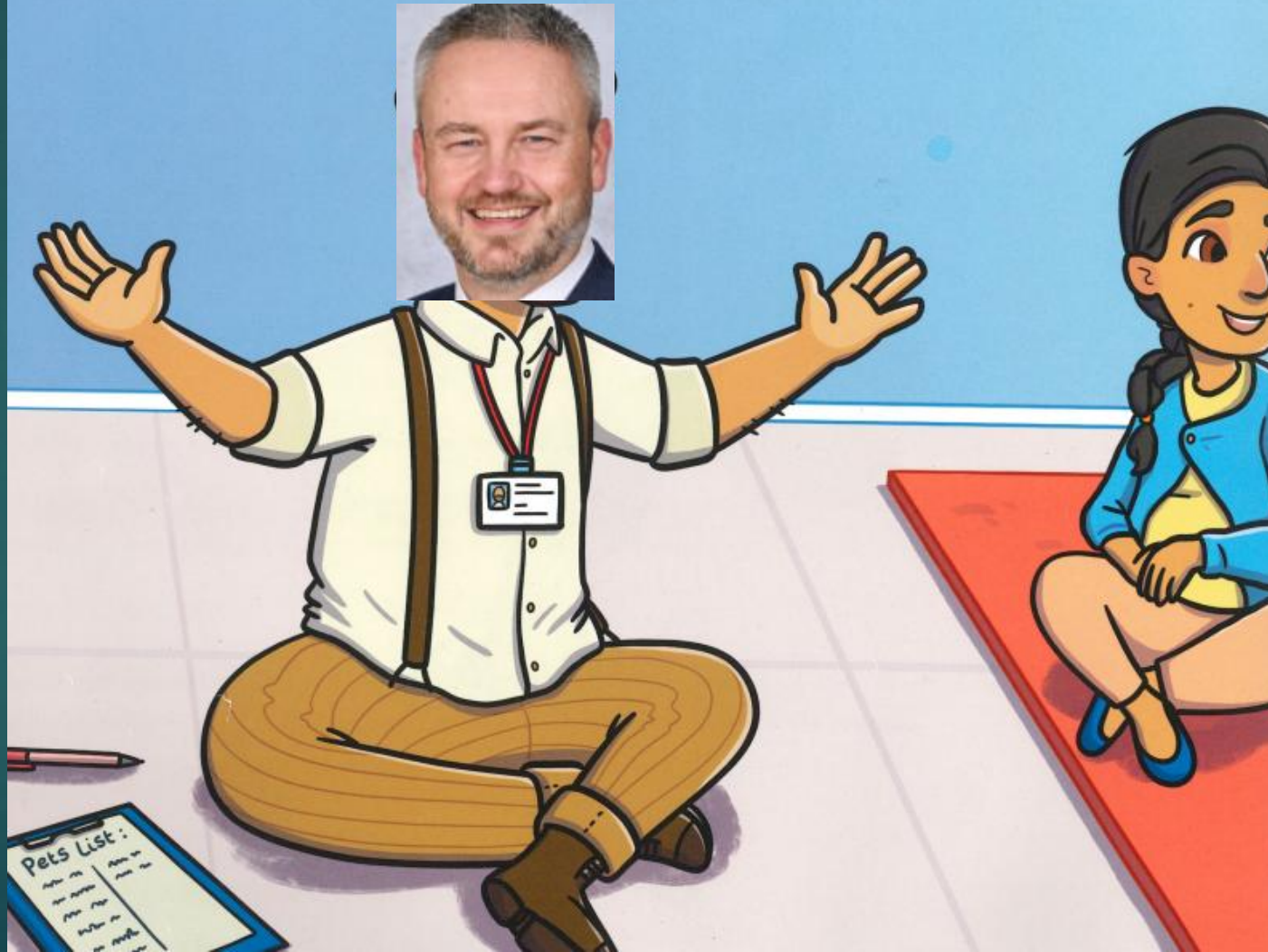

As the week went on, the teachers excitedly told each other all about their pets.

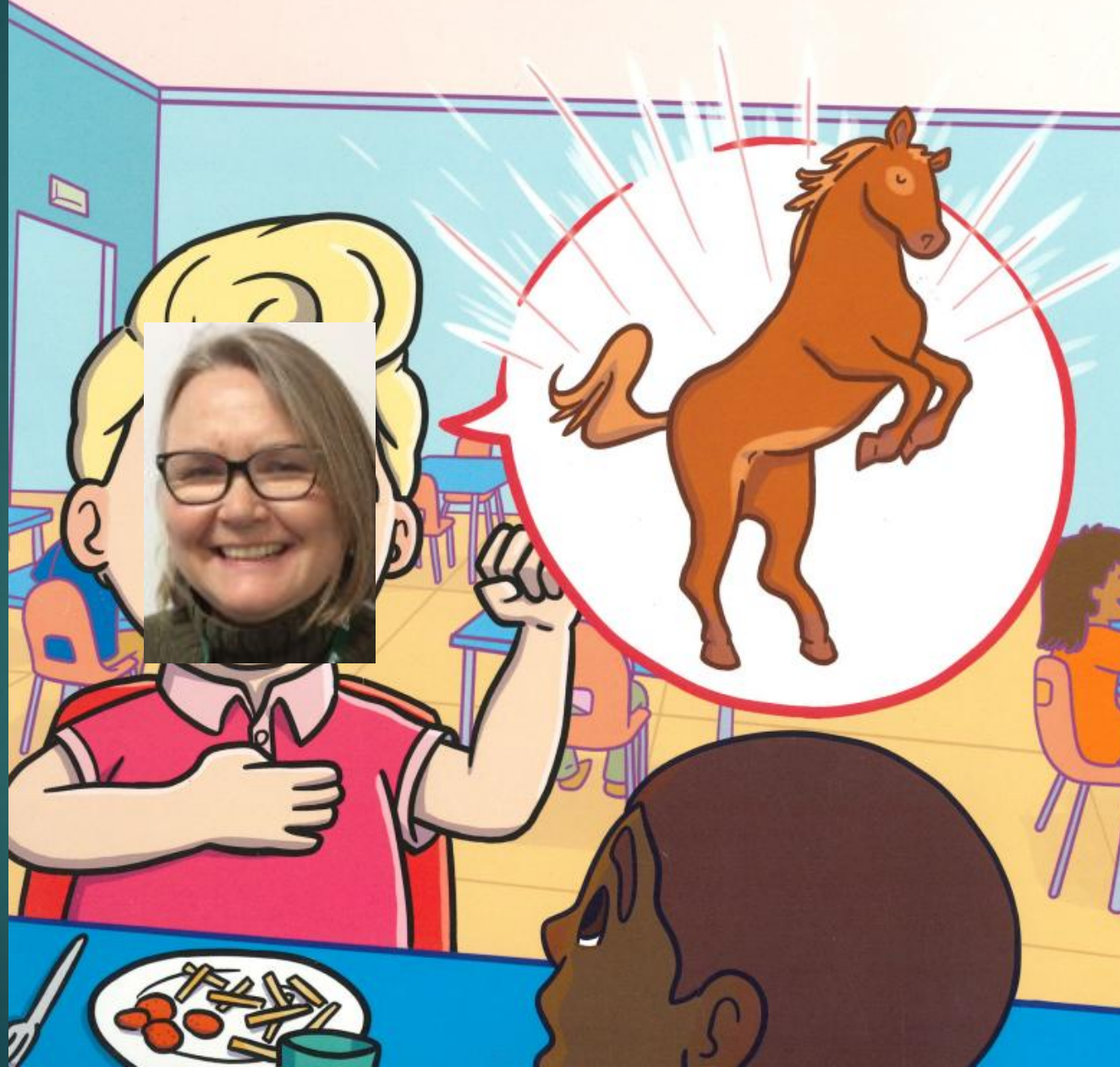
“My cat is so fierce,” said Mrs Holland “You’ll have to be careful of his really sharp claws!”



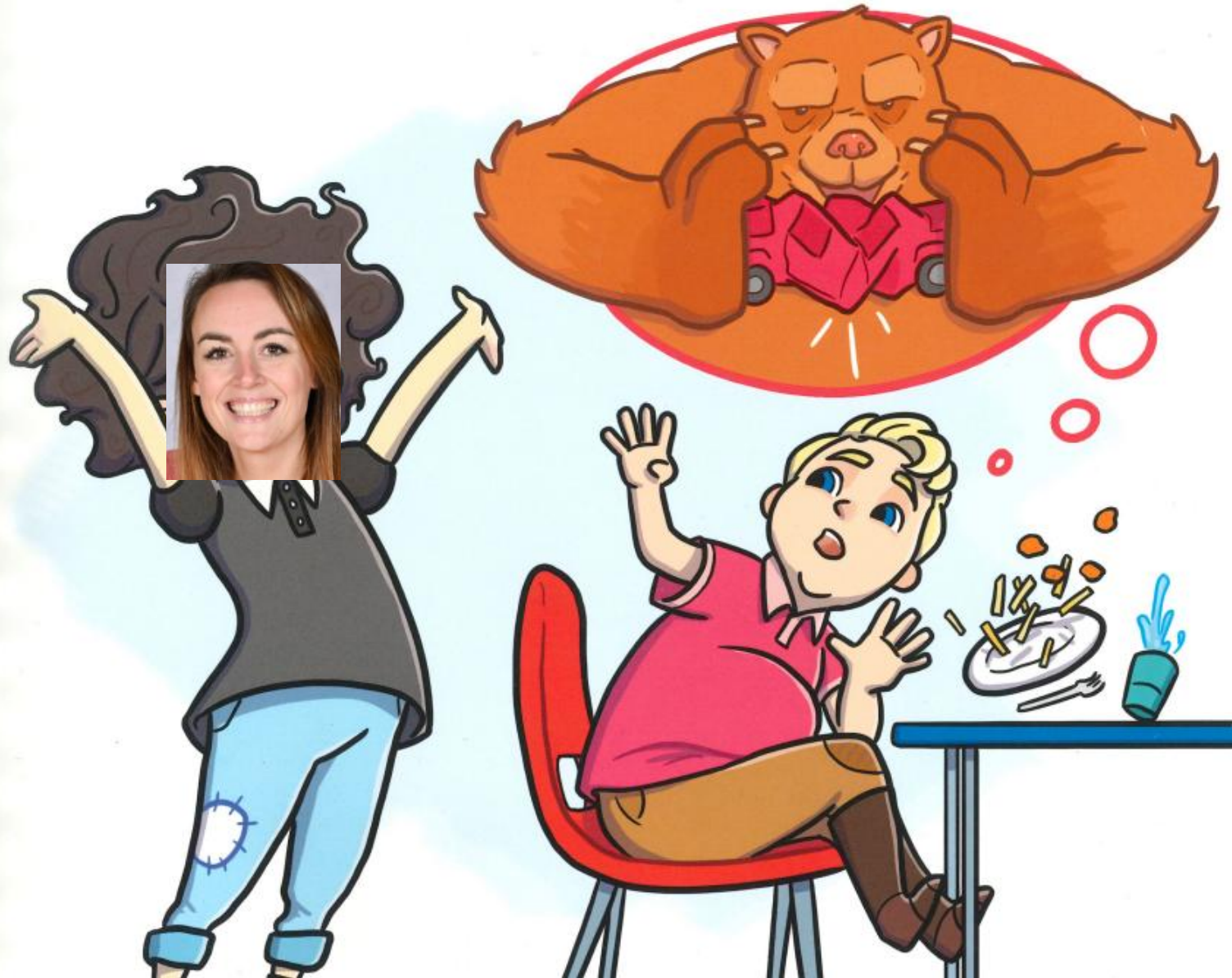

"My dog is so messy," said Mrs Simmons Her face gets all covered in food when she eats her dinner!"



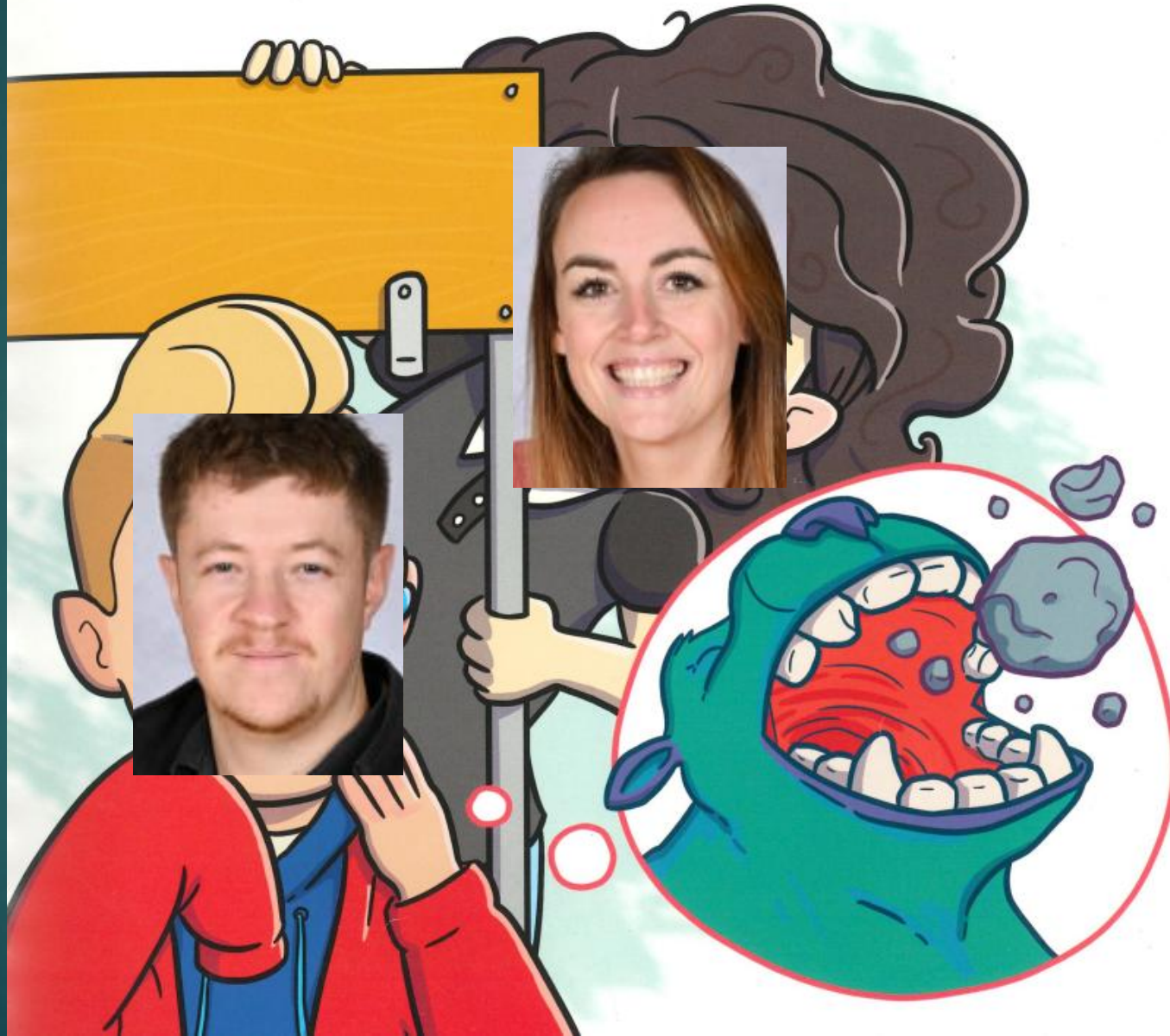

O’Dowd “He’s so greedy, he can eat a whole cabbage in one go!”



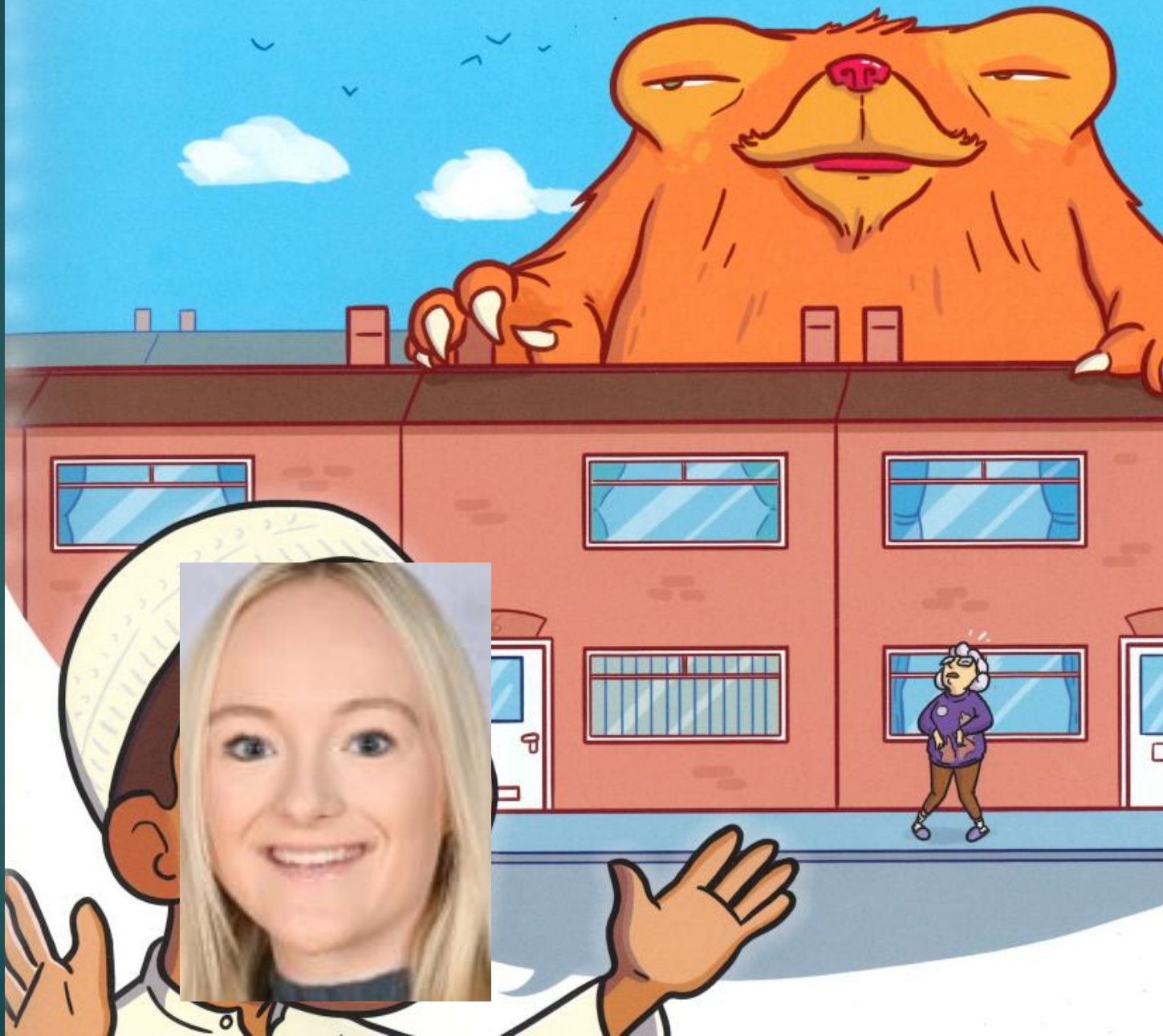

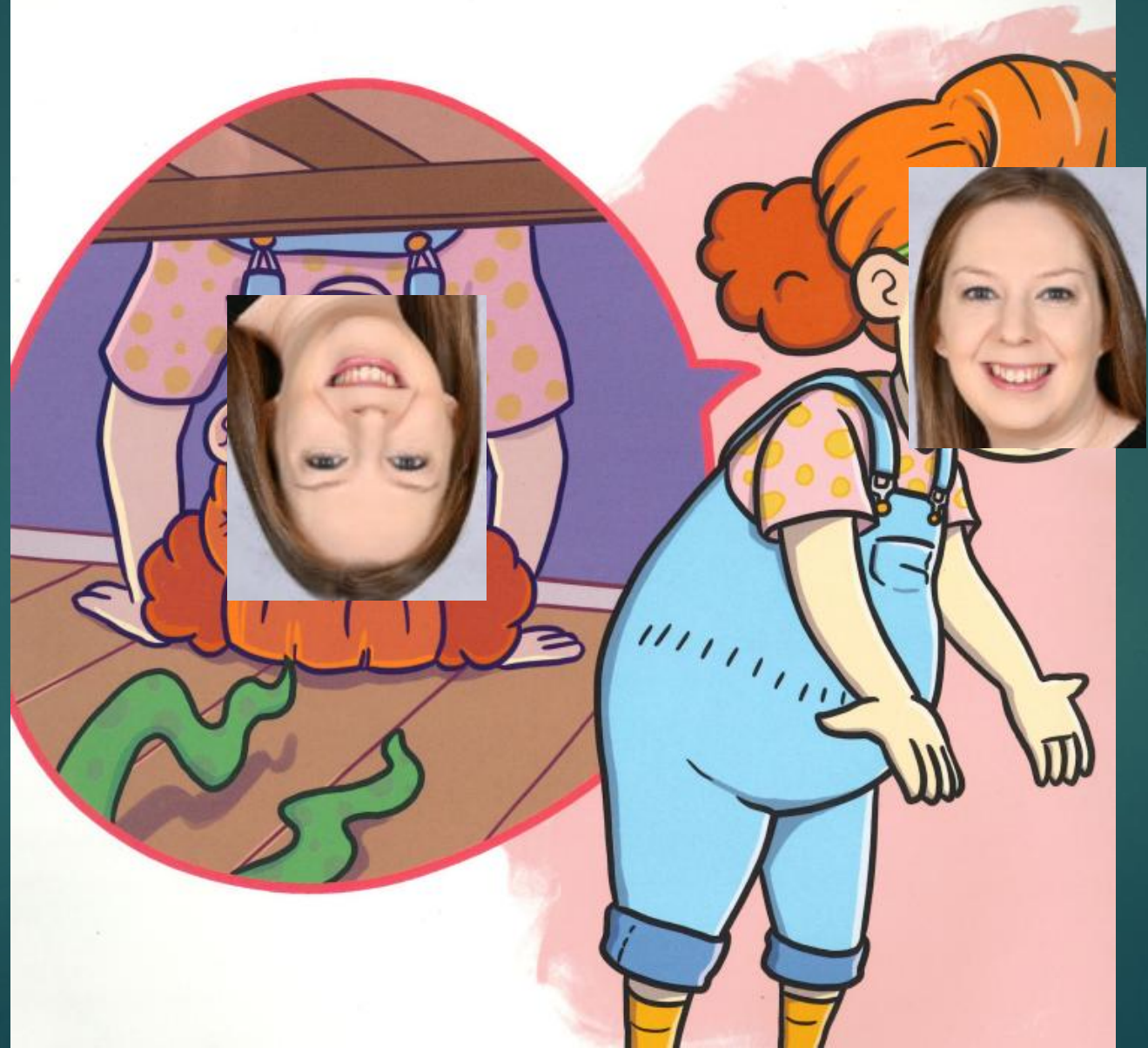
The days passed and as Pet Day started to get closer,

"I heard Sid is bigger than a house!" said Miss McNally.



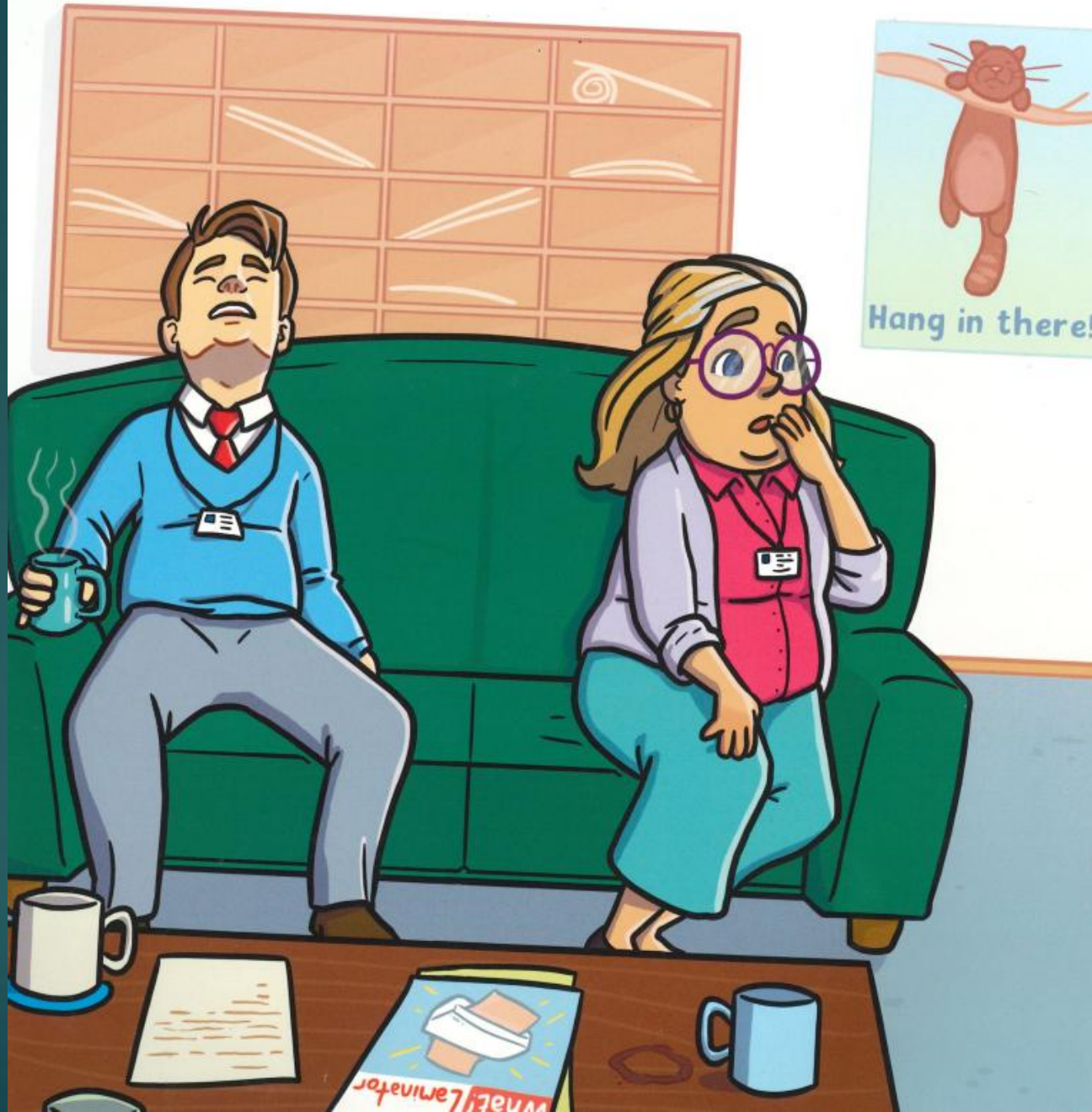
"I heard he hides under your bed waiting to eat you for dinner!" said Miss Whitbread.

“What if he knocks the school down?” said Mrs Welch



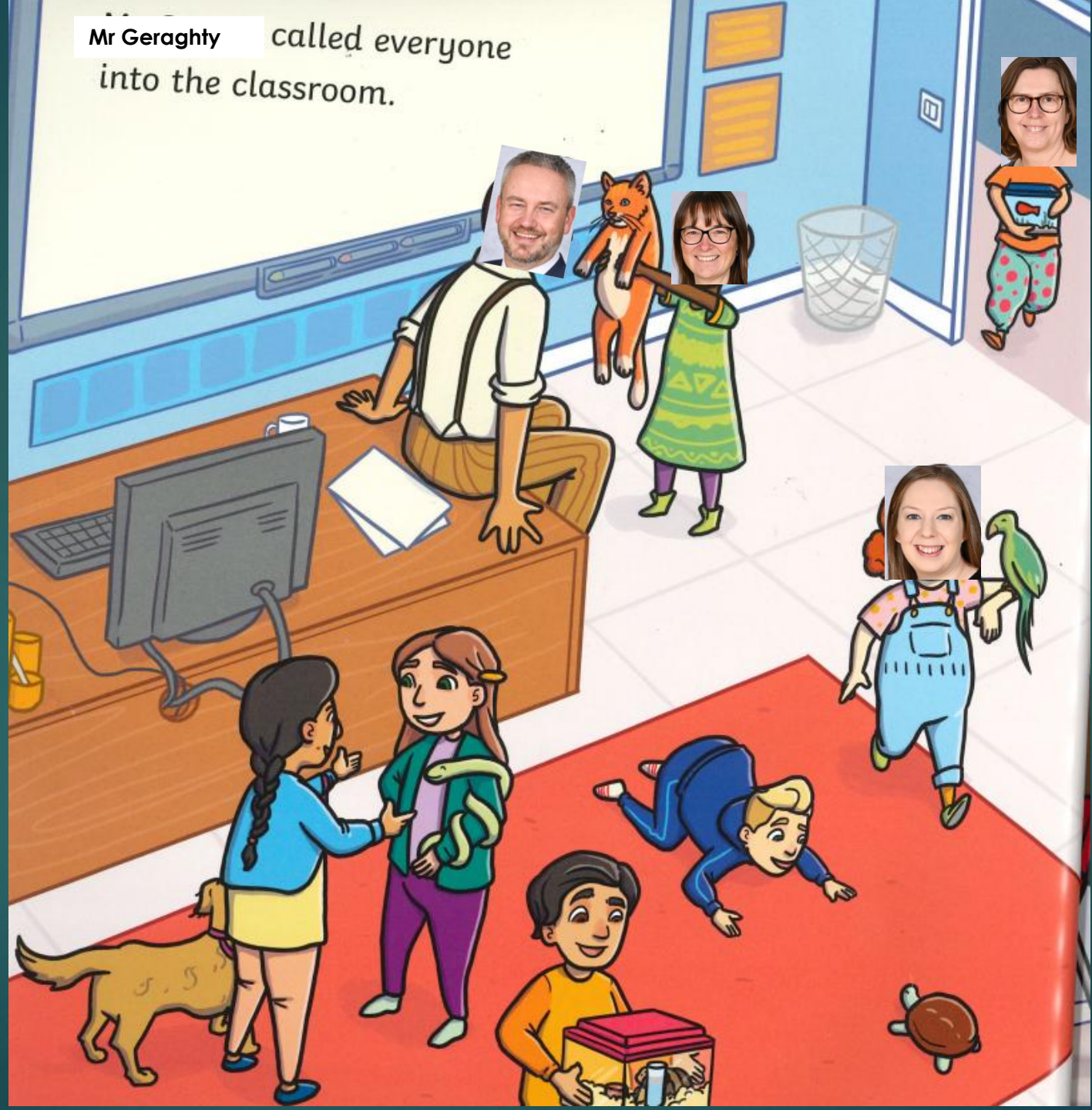
“What if he eats all our lunches?” whimpered Mrs Bertacchini

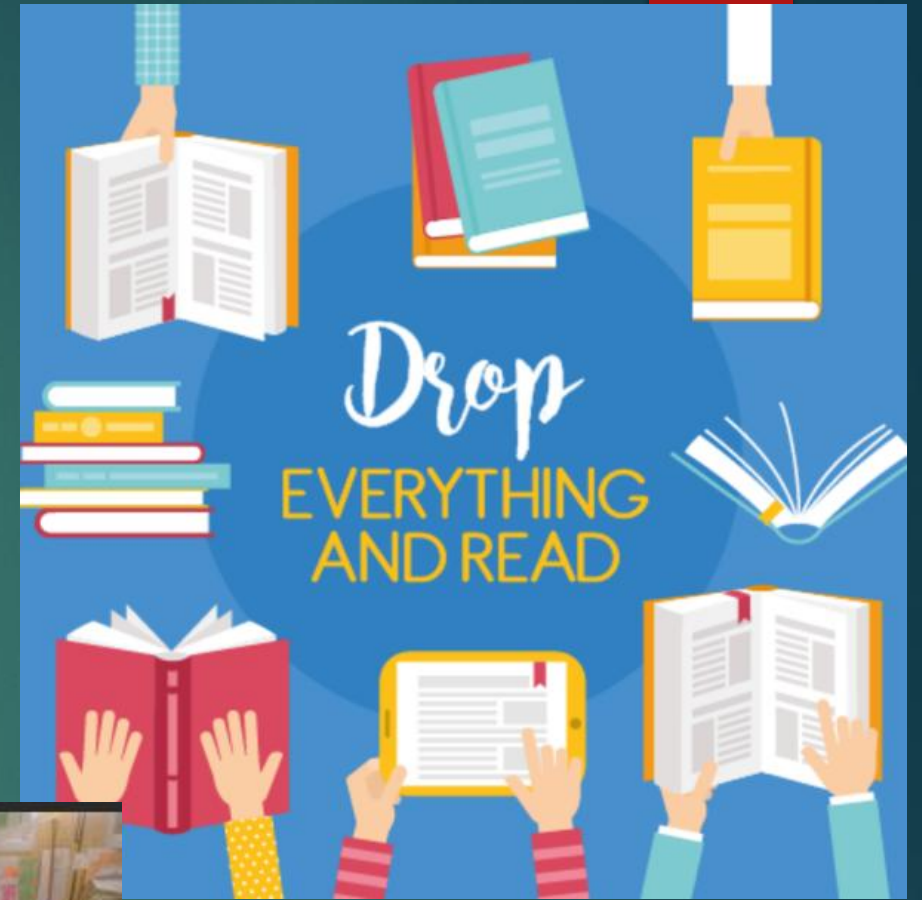
