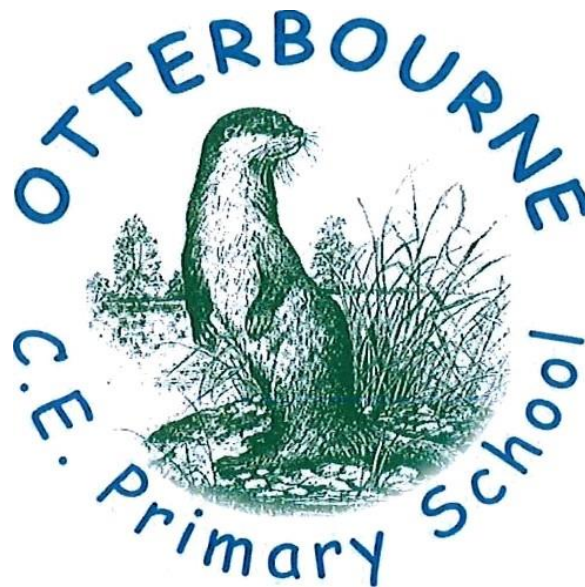

# Home School Agreement Document

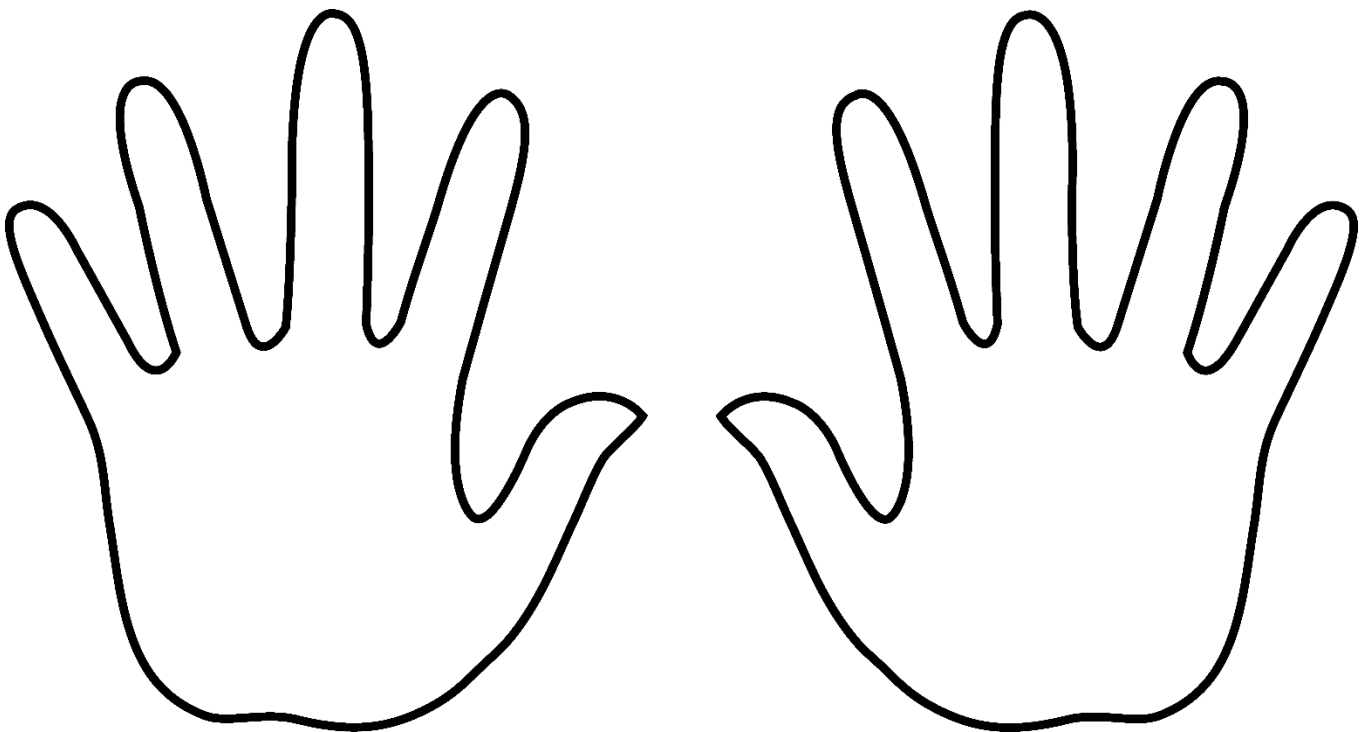
